

## Ericson Elementary Communication to Families Traffic and Safety Concern(s) and Solutions

To ensure the safety of our students and community, we have worked with community members, City Officials, as well as PTA Safety Committee to implement the following solutions to resolve or at least alleviate the concern(s) we are hearing from families and our own observations and data collection. Please read the information below to keep abreast of how we are supporting solutions to these concerns.

Traffic and/or Safety Concern(s)	Solution(s)		
Pedestrian Crosswalk	<ul> <li>Communicate with families to cross as a group versus individually.</li> <li>Communicate with families to <u>NOT</u> cross when a car has passed the crosswalk or is in the intersection.</li> <li>When staffing is available, Family Volunteers and/or Ericson Staff will be present to support flow of pedestrian crossing and vehicle traffic.</li> </ul>		
Difficult to drop-off children for school	<ul> <li>Ericson implemented the Drop Off Zone in mid-October with Parent Volunteers and the Viking Squad providing support.</li> <li>Drop Off Zone is open from 7:25 a.m 7:40 a.m.</li> <li>Cones and signs are set up daily to provide guidance and safety around the Drop Off Zone. Please view the Drop Off Zone map for traffic flow.</li> </ul>		
Red Zones and Blocking Neighbors' Driveway	<ul> <li>When available, SDUSD Campus Police will be out to inform and/or ticket vehicles in violation of the red zones.</li> <li>When staffing is available, Family Volunteers and/or Ericson Staff will be present to remind families to not park in red zones or blocking neighbors' driveway.</li> </ul>		
Illegal Maneuvers	<ul> <li>When available, SDUSD Campus Police will be out to inform and/or ticket vehicles in violation of illegal U-turns and left turns.</li> <li>When staffing is available, Ericson Staff will be out to inform families of illegal U-turns and left turns, etc.</li> </ul>
